Privacy Policy

(eff. January 1, 2019)

Our company is committed to protecting the privacy of our clients and policyholders. Title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA) generally prohibits any financial institution, directly or through its affiliates, from sharing nonpublic personal information about you with a nonaffiliated third party unless the institution provides you with a notice of its privacy policies and practices, such as the type of information that it collects about you and the categories of persons or entities to whom it may be disclosed. In compliance with the GLBA, we are providing you with this document, which notifies you of the privacy policies and practices of Penn Land Transfer Company.

Collection of Information:

We may collect nonpublic personal information from the following sources:

- Information we receive from our clients, such as on applications or other forms.
- Information that we receive from others involved in insuring transactions, such as real estate brokers, agents and lenders.
- Information we obtain from public sources, such as land and court records.

No additional nonpublic personal information will be collected about you, unless it is specifically stated otherwise in documents related to a specific transaction, or an amended Privacy Policy Notice.

Disclosure of Information:

We may disclose any of the above information to the following:

- To third-parties who provide services in the course of our business.
- Our affiliates or non-affiliated third parties, as permitted by law.
- State/Federal Regulators, law enforcement agencies and auditors.

We do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about you with anyone for any purpose that is not permitted by law.

We restrict access to nonpublic personal information to those employees who need to know that information in order to provide our services. We train our employees on the importance of protecting the privacy and safety of personal information, and maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards in compliance with federal standards to protect nonpublic personal information.

Website:

- You may visit our website without providing any nonpublic personal financial information to us.
- The only nonpublic personal financial information we collect from a visitor to our website is that which is provided voluntarily.
- Our website may contain links to other sites. While we endeavor to link only to websites which share our high standards and respect for personal privacy, we are not responsible for the content or the privacy practices used by those websites
